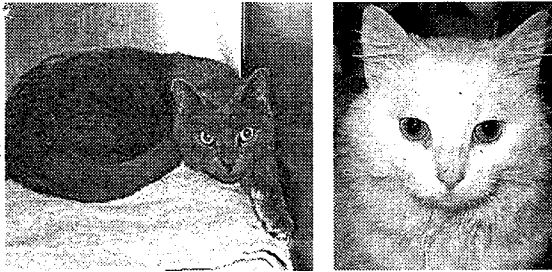
NOAH'S ARK ANIMAL WELFARE ASSOCIATION
